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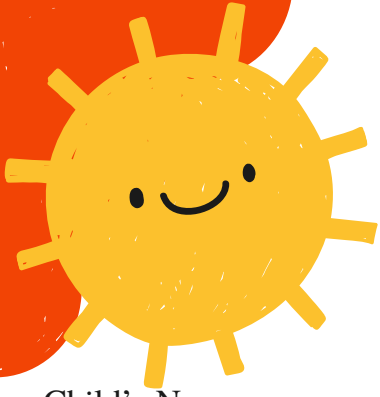

RELEASE AND STATEMENT AGREEMENT

Child's Name _____

___ **ENROLLMENT FEE:** A summer enrollment fee of \$30 is required with this application to reserve your child's spot. This fee is non-refundable.

___ **PAYMENT AGREEMENT:** I understand that children enrolled for complete weeks and that my agreement to pay charges for each full week is not subject to adjustment for illness or absence. I agree to pay, when applicable, other fees. These may include registration, hourly daycare, or late pickup charges. I understand that my child may be denied admission to camp if tuition or fees are not paid in a timely manner.

___ **LATE PICKUP CHARGES:** Late pickups will be charged \$1 per minute.

___ **MEDICAL RELEASE:** I do hereby grant permission to BOSMMA Summer Camp to secure such medical aid and hospital service as the employees of BOSMMA deem necessary for my child in the event he/she should sustain an injury or illness while attending camp. I understand that a body temperature of 100 degrees or more will require me to immediately pick up my child from camp.

___ **MEDIA RELEASE:** I acknowledge that my child might be photographed while participating in camp activities and that these photos may be used by BOSMMA for the promotion and marketing of BOSMMA Summer Camp. I understand that it is my responsibility to notify BOSMMA, in writing, if I do not wish to have my child photographed.

___ **ILLNESS:** To protect all children, your child will not be accepted at the center if he/she has any of the following symptoms: a fever, a rash or eye infection that has not been diagnosed, or any diarrhea or vomiting. Children must be fever-free and vomit-free for 24 hours before returning to school. If your child develops any of the above symptoms while in the center, he/she will be isolated from the other children, parents will be contacted by phone, and the child must be picked up within one hour of that phone call.

___ **AUTHORIZATION FOR SUNSCREEN:** I give permission to BOSMMA to apply sunscreen cream which I provided for my child as necessary during the day. The sunscreen must be labeled with the child's name and placed in a Ziplock® bag.

___ **LUNCH / SUPPLIES AGREEMENT:** I agree to provide food and drinks for my child. I agree to provide extra clothes and socks, wipes, and any other supplies my child may need while in care. BOSMMA will not be responsible for damaged or missing personal possessions. Pizza Friday lunch is available for \$4/week (1 slice) or \$5/week (2 slices).
